## New Year Update

We hope all our families had a nice summer break. We also realize that many have been affected by the current CARR Fire. As a school, we were impacted by ash on campus. While the Shasta County Health Department has determined the ash to be non-toxic on sites away from the actual burn areas, we did have a company come in and clean the entire campus, including the blue mulch in the play areas. Air filters have been changed and will be changed regularly until the smoke and ash clear.

School will begin as normally scheduled for students on Wednesday, August 15.

As we are anticipating continued poor air quality, the following precautions will be taken:

151 – 200	<p><u>For students with asthma or high sensitivity to air quality:</u> A room will be available during recesses and. Activities will be available for the students in this room.</p> <p><u>Other Students:</u> Reduced activity on the playground (minimal running, students encouraged to take sit-down breaks and drink increased amounts of water).</p> <p>PE will only be held indoors</p>
201+	<p><u>All Students:</u> All recesses will be indoors.</p> <p>No PE activities (indoors or outdoors)</p>

### **Monday, August 13**

6:00 pm: **Back to School Night for Kindergarten parents** in the multipurpose room. We will have supervision on the playground for students to minimize distractions during the presentations to parents.

### **Wednesday, August 15**

School begins for all students at 8:20 am. There will be a continental breakfast setup for parents in the multipurpose room to enjoy after dropping of their student beginning at 8:00 am. School is out for students in grades K-3 at 2:30 pm and at 3:00 for students in grades 4-8.

**Friday, August 17** is a minimum day with all students dismissed at 12:00 noon.

- 6:00 pm: **Back to School Night (Grades 1 – 8):** Teachers in grades 1-8 will hold two information sessions for parents to give an overview on their classroom policies.
