Seven Habits & Leadership

The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People is a key component of our building within students strategies for success. The 7 Habits is a synthesis of universal, timeless principles of personal and interpersonal effectiveness, such as responsibility, vision, integrity, teamwork, collaboration and renewal, which are secular in nature and common to all people and cultures. Along with learning the Habits, students are learning hand signals to go along with each — parents are encouraged to "test" their students on the signals!

Our implementation of these habits is also aligned to many national and state academic standards. The process teaches students the skills needed for academic success in any setting. These skills include critical thinking, goal setting, listening and speaking, self-directed learning, presentation-making and the ability to work in

groups.

As a staff we are excited to integrate these skills into our instructional processes and the school environment. More information and resources will be coming home that our families can use in the weeks ahead.


Our fall BOOK FAIR will be underway next week on Wednesday, Thursday and

YourArt is a drawing based program created to teach children how to draw and widen their knowledge and love for art while having fun in a safe and stress free environment for children in grades K-8. Your child will be introduced to a variety of exciting mediums including watercolor pencils, charcoal, oil pastels and much more! A new project will be created each week and projects will not ever repeat.

YourArt Certified Art Instructors will teach your child a step by step drawing technique in each class as well as art history and terminology. YourArt uses professional artist quality materials and all materials are included in session fees. Your child will bring home a new masterpiece and leave our classroom with confidence, pride, and a new lesson of art after each class!

Best part is there is no extra driving required! Classes are held on campus at North Cow Creek. Each class begins 5 minutes after school is out in a designated classroom and kindergartners will be picked up at their classroom and walked over to art class. Students will not ever go unsupervised.

Sessions are typically 9 weeks long, taught one day a week, and each class is one hour long. There is an option to pay per class with pre-reg. required.


